Week of Respect Activities Oct. 5-9, 2015

Monday - 10/5/15 - Students will wear a **BLUE** shirt for *World Day of Bullying Prevention*. Also, during morning announcements the song "RESPECT" by Aretha Franklin will play over the intercom. Students are encouraged to sing along and dance.

Tuesday - 10/6/15 - Students will wear **YELLOW** for the Character Education Theme of RESPECT. Students are asked to remember the "Golden Rule" -- treat others as you would like to be treated.

Wednesday - 10/7/15 - Character Education Lessons Begin
Teachers will play the Life Vest Boomerang video (<http://www.lifevestinside.com/projects/film/>) in grades K-5 and have a class discussion.

Thursday - 10/8/15 - "Day of Tolerance" Classes will be scheduled for a character education lesson with Mrs. Jacobson in the morning. A story will be read to the students about Tolerance/Respect. Kindergarten will be paired with Fifth grade, First grade will be paired with Fourth grade, and Second grade will be paired with Third grade to work on a RESPECT project with their partners. Three "Rays of Respect" suns will be created from the three different groups, one representing Respect of Self, one representing Respect of Others, and one representing Respect of Community.

Friday - 10/9/15 - "Arms Around Salem Drive" Students and staff will form a circle in the front of the school and sing the character education song and school song.
